AirSoft Rifle Flash Suppressor Adapter

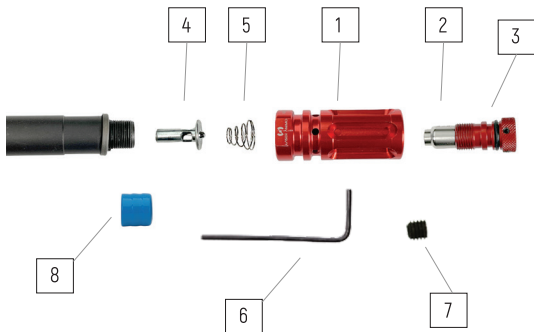

Always store your ammunition (pellets, BBs)
in an area that is separate from your training area.

Customer can purchase a Flash Kit (With the SureStrike™ Laser Cartridge) to use with his own Airsoft rifle, or as a part of a Recoil Enabled Rifle.

(*) This user guide applies to all Flash products from Laser Ammo.

Parts



1. Flash adapter
2. Laser cartridge
3. Front retainer
4. Firing Pin
5. Spring
6. Allen key
7. Spare screw
8. Battery for Laser

SureStrike™ Laser Assembly

1. Assemble the Laser cartridge by first inserting the battery pack into the Laser module, flat side (+) facing away from the laser (up). Thread the cap on to the Laser module. Push the black premier on the cap of the assembled cartridge to insure the laser is working correctly.



2. Insert the Surestrike™ cartridge (2) into the Red front retainer (3) with the laser body entering first, leaving the cap on the outside of the retainer. Make sure the Allen screws are opened enough to allow the cartridge to seat at the bottom of the retainer. Ensure front of laser is flush with the Retainer. Gently screw in all Allen screws equally until they bottom out but do not tighten.



3. For the Flash Kit to be used on user own Airsoft, remove the flash suppressor by unscrewing it, please note the threads are commonly left hand and may also be fastened by a pin. Make sure you have the correct 14mm thread FLASH adaptor before proceeding.



Flash Assembly

4. Thread the Red front retainer assembly into the suppressor Adapter (1) until it bottoms out, then thread it back out only enough to place the first Allen screw pointing up. This will allow adjustment points for windage and elevation.



5. Hold the rifle without the flash suppressor, with the barrel pointing up. Place the firing pin on the barrel of the rifle, and place the spring on top of the firing pin; wide side out.



6. Screw the Suppressor adapter onto the muzzle of your Air Soft rifle and tighten.



Windage & Elevation

The retainer has 4 adjustment screws for aligning the laser. The screws on the sides are used for windage, and the screws on the top and bottom are used for elevation.



- Holding your Airsoft rifle, preferably on a rest for accuracy, fire at your target from the distance you would normally practice at.
- If your shot is to the left, adjust by unscrewing the screw on the right side and tighten the screw on the left. Do not overtighten.
- If your shot is higher, adjust by unscrewing the screw on the bottom and tighten the screw on the top. Do not overtighten.

Always begin by opening the opposite screw first, to allow the cartridge to move as you tighten the other side.



Always keep your firearm pointed away from you.

Changing the Battery

The battery may be changed without opening the alignment Allen screws and losing adjustments.

- Unscrew and remove the front retainer assembly (3).



- Unscrew the action cap (cap only! Leave the laser inside the retainer) and remove the old battery.
- Reassemble with new battery.



Laser Maintenance & Service

The Surestrike™ Laser Cartridge is an electronic device and should always be treated as such.

Wipe the Laser cartridge only with a soft fabric - do not immerse in solvents or cleaning agents.

Clean the laser lens using a glass cleaner and cotton swab.

Take out battery when not in use.

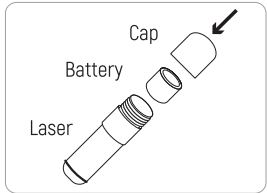

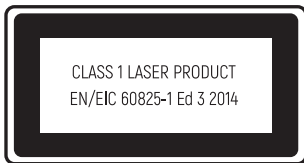
Laser Maintenance & Service

- The SureStrike™ cartridge is comprised of three (3) components: Laser, battery and cap. The cartridge is controlled by vibration.



- Laser Ammo warranty the back cap for a minimum of 5,000 shots. After that, the firing cap can be expected to wear and fail to fire the laser. If you experience such wear, contact Laser Ammo to purchase a replacement cap. Follow the battery changing procedures to replace the cap.
- This Laser Product is designated as Class 1 during all procedures of operation, maintenance and service. No scheduled maintenance is necessary to keep the product in compliance.
- It is strictly forbidden to modify the Cartridge. Opening of Cartridge is limited to battery replacement only.
